Patch Tuesday for Microsoft and other vendors for December 2019

Dear Constituents,

Microsoft's has released their December 2019 Patch Tuesday security updates. They have released 2 advisories and updates for 36 vulnerabilities. Out of these vulnerabilities, 7 are classified as Critical, 27 as Important, 1 as Moderate, and 1 as Low.
